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SPORTS GRANT 2016-2017 £9,635

The sports grant is to be used to continue to support the programme of work in Year 4,5 and 6. Most children will access high quality sports provision at Leigh Sports Village. There is a balance of using local coaches to provide alternative sports eg archery, fencing and dance; There will be additional funding from the school budget to fund this. This year we have also extended this to Year 2 and Year 3, where an additional member of staff has been deployed to make the groups smaller in size and more manageable to ensure progress. This also includes a specialist teacher taking Yoga with the children to improve their health and well-being.
