<p>Autumn 1</p> <p><u>WWII</u> – an in-depth look at WWII, when it began, why, and the impacts it had on us today. Explore what life was like as an evacuee.</p> <p><u>Light</u> – a scientific exploration of light sources, reflection and shadows.</p>	<p>Spring 1</p> <p><u>Rocks</u> - a scientific investigation into rocks of all kinds, including fossils and the famous volcanoes around the world.</p> <p><u>Under The Sea</u> – A exploratory visit under the sea! Children will look at a variety of creatures found under the sea and explore their habitats. They will develop their needle work skills whilst making a fabric sea creature, and look at the work of Paul Glee to create a piece of under the sea art.</p>	<p>Summer 1</p> <p><u>Ancient Greece</u> - a study into the life of the Ancient Greeks, how they lived, worked, food, clothing and a chance to create our own authentic Greek pots.</p> <p><u>Forces</u> – magnets; will they repel or attract each other? Explore magnetic and non-magnetic materials and discover how objects move along different surfaces.</p>
<p>Autumn 2</p> <p><u>A Christmas Special</u> – a look back at the magical nativity story, where children perform to an audience, speak publicly, work collaboratively and engage in role play. Children will also design, make and evaluate a Christmas product.</p>	<p>Spring 2</p> <p><u>UK Geography</u> – a study of the United Kingdom including hills, rivers, coasts and mountains, with a look at the local environment and changes over time.</p>	<p>Summer 2</p> <p><u>Romans</u> – a study into the life of the Romans, how they lived, work, food and clothing and a look at the legacy they have left behind.</p> <p><u>Our Body</u> - learn about our body's, our support systems and how we function, as well as a look at how animals function. Explore what we need as humans to survive.</p>
