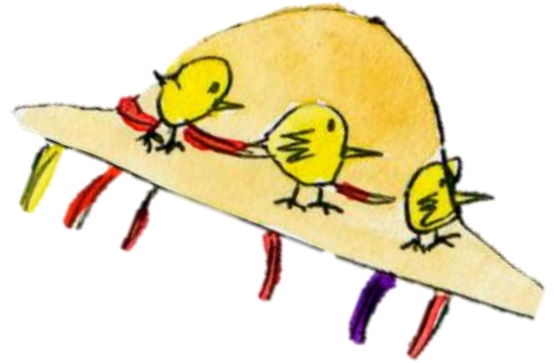
### Easter Bonnet Parades:
