So that we follow the government COVID guidelines we **MUST** have staggered drop off and pick up to limit the number of families on the school site. Please can I ask that you follow this as we need to make sure all our families and staff are kept safe. If possible, try to arrive close to your allocated time so there's no queuing out of school.

If you have children in multiple year groups please drop off in the order you walk round the playgrounds – this may mean that some of the older children are dropped off out of their allocated time but we have allowed for this in our risk assessment.

Year 5 and Year 6 children **must** come onto the school grounds on their own. We are trying to minimise the number of people on the school playground at any one time. A member of staff will be on each gate during drop off.

Nursery Children's drop off and pick up will remain the same – please make sure you are socially distancing.
