### Headteacher Update

Good afternoon,

This week has been an eventful week in school with lots happening in classrooms which show how dedicated your children are to learning.

Also, I have introduced a <u>Parent, Carer & Visitor Code of Conduct</u> in school. Please ensure that you have read the policy and made anyone who picks your children up from school aware of this policy.

I must make very clear that there has been some behaviour in school recently where some children have been hurt. Any incidents that occur in school are dealt with in an age-appropriate way. It is our policy that we do not share information about consequences for children with anyone who does not have parental responsibility for that child. This policy is in every school and forms part of the safeguarding procedures in school. However, I must urge you that if you are unhappy about the way a situation has been dealt with, not about the children or the individual involved, then please escalate this in the appropriate way as stated in the safeguarding section of this newsletter. Please do not approach parents on the playground, as this can sometimes make the situation worse and can in some instances lead to legal consequences.
