Attainment for PP pupils at KS2 pupils is narrowed in reading, writing and maths combined and is in line with local and national averages.

Appointment of a third teacher in Year 6, impact being demonstrated has allowed the Assistant Headteacher and Maths Lead to support with co-coaching of teachers in the delivery of teaching in maths following a consistent approach.

PiXL assessments are also completed termly with QLA to ensure that PiXL Teaching Strategies can address the gaps in learning across KS2. PiXL assessment scores are now tracked for all pupils across the school and pupils begin assessments in Year 1 (From the Spring Term).

Priority 1: To raise the attendance of PP pupils to narrow the gap between PP pupils' national attendance. Bringing PP pupils in line with the national average.
